### **Brachiopod Boardwalk Progress**

The reconstructed Brachiopod Boardwalk was completed and opened early last summer (2020). This was a joint project of the Friends and the DNR. The Friends also provided a new information kiosk there, which was dedicated to the support and service of Friends members Carl and Ruth Scholz. We are currently working on additional upgrades to this trail that include new signage, trail grading near the boardwalk, and two accessible parking spaces. We've been notified that we have received a Knowles-Nelson grant of \$20,000 (which we will match) to complete the work on this project! We're working with a naturalist/designer to replace and create new signage along the trail. Plans also include two accessible parking spaces adjacent to the trail and some regrading. Thanks to all who have contributed funds and/or hours to this project.

### Wish List

New Friends President John Swanson has led the Board in creating a "wish list" of projects to guide our work and budget over the next year. Projects include:

- Brachiopod Trail: Interpretive Signage. In progress. Accessible Parking: In progress.
- Pollinator Garden Signage: \$500-\$900. COMPLETED. ID tags added.
- Fire Ring with lockable top (in picnic area): COMPLETED.
- Native American Village: Repair, rebuild, and expand existing structures. Update signage.
- Document storage in a cloud drive for Board. In progress.
- Trailer to transport skid steer from other properties for use at WFDSP. Researching options.
- **Nature Center Kiosk:** Will be built near the nature center to hold the Park map/directory created by the DNR & other information. Applying for a grant to help fund.
- Access Trail to Cave Point Park: Work with Door County Parks and DNR to design, fund, and construct.
- **Old Baldy:** Upgrade the board walk up to the platform. Consider handrails. Remove trees that obstruct the view for park visitors.
- Electric Vehicle Charging Station: Dirks is investigating this possible project.
