- **BRACHIOPOD TRAIL**: Grading, apply gravel where needed, create handicapped parking area, signage as needed. Bench (perhaps two) at the lookout point. *Funds have been applied for to accomplish some of these areas*.
- NATURALIST: Secure funding for 2021 and beyond. There is some funding already in place for this.
- **GROOMING EQUIPMENT:** In the past we have put aside \$1,000 per year for replacement some date in the future.
- GARAGE DOOR: On the west side of the cold shop to make for easier use of the snowmobile equipment.
- **SKID STEER EQUIPMENT:** Used is about \$14,000, new about \$33,000.
- PARK SIGNAGE: Replacement and/or repair: We have received \$1000 (matching funds) from FWISP.
- **OLD BALDY:** Make it more accessible. May include repair of the stairway and boardwalks as needed; addition of handrails; trimming trees around platform to expand view; and potentially adding another platform above the existing one, to approximately 9 feet, or 15 steps, higher.
- **POLLINATOR GARDEN:** Signage needed.
- **NATIVE AMERICAN VILLAGE:** Repair/rebuild existing structures, to be coordinated with the county historical society. Signage. Expansion?
- WHITEFISH BAY CREEK AREA: Repair of the boardwalk; create a trail between the boardwalk to join the spur trail. Add a short boardwalk along the creek towards Clark Lake Road.
- TRAIL BETWEEN CAVE POINT COUNTY AND WHITEFISH DUNES STATE PARK: A permanent trail needs to be developed between the two parks to protect the bluff, trees and plants, as well as to ensure safety to walkers on the trail.

Note that this is not a ranked list. The Board will consider ranking these wishes at a future meeting. Your input is appreciated.
