- 5. Premium money will be distributed Sunday, June 9th from 12:00 2:00 P.M. (CST).
- 6. All premium money not claimed by 2:00 P.M. (CST) June 9th will be returned to the Jaycees. No premiums will be mailed.
- 7. Ribbons, not claimed by 2:00 P.M. (CST) Sunday, June 9th may be picked up at the Russell County Extension Office, Russell Springs, KY (866-4477).
- 8. <u>Fair workers, volunteers, nor Extension Agents are responsible for items left in Floral Hall after 2:00 P.M. (CST) Sunday, June 9th.</u>
- 9. Chairman or appointed person has the right to remove items that are perishable.
- 10. All items must be made or grown by the exhibitor.
- 11. Only exhibits in classes listed in Fair Catalog will be judged.
- 12. Only one exhibit per class per household. Multiple entries in the same class are not allowed.
- 13. Judges will select a Grand Champion from the blue-ribbon winners in each department. The winning exhibit will receive a grand champion ribbon. <u>No</u> additional premium money will be paid on this award.
- 14. Judges' decisions are final.
- 15. No item can be entered from previous Russell County Fairs.
- 16. All classes pay \$7.00 for 1st place, \$5.00 for 2nd place, and \$3.00 for 3rd place unless otherwise specified. 4-H classes pay \$10.00, \$7.00, and \$5.00.
