We are following all of the changes that are happening with great interest. The impact of the C-19 virus has surely been felt everywhere! We had plans to return stateside April-July, however, we were unable to change plans in time to leave in March due to travel restrictions and border closures, so we remain in Zambia! We also had to cancel teams that were scheduled to come in April, and August but we remain HOPEFUL to still host a team in November.

The virus has caused many new changes to be implemented, very much in keeping with the recommendations of Western culture. Masks, shelter in place, no gatherings of more than 50 (with a permit is required), schools and many businesses have been closed. With this culture being a hand to mouth existence, these mandates have caused starvation and homelessness to be a greater risk than the virus itself. People literally sell goods today that can generate funds to buy food for today, and many are desperate. Thankfully the harvest season is now, and for that we are so thankful!

We have been pleased to FINISH the major part of the building for Chikoka Bible Baptist Church! We hired Mateo Sakala as general contractor, and what a wonderful job he has done! There is a very long story behind this, and we hope to share it with you someday! Until then, just know that God has worked in and through this young man, and we are so very thankful to have had a small part in it!
