We are at the end of a very full three months of ministry! We hosted a medical clinic at Chikoka BBC, and over 800 people were helped with medical and dental needs. The church members stepped up volunteering in many ways: translating, enrolling, and evangelizing to name a few. The 8 days of ministry ran smoothly and was a wonderful way to show and share the Love of Our God! We also hosted two men from a supporting church in New Hampshire. We held a Leadership Conference for several days, teaching through the qualities and qualifications laid out in 1 Timothy 3. We made audio files of all the sessions and they will be available for the churches to rehearse the lessons over and over.

They have over 350 students in enrollment, and only two very overused toilets. We will be building 4 - 2 sided toilets, for a total of 8. This is a Much Needed addition to the school! The classrooms are over crowded, and they have many other challenges but we are grateful for this school! We hope to make more investment into the students in the coming years, and we ask for prayer and the Lord's guidance as to what He would have us do.

The churches continue to do well, and have organized regular meetings for youth, women, and "All Church United" services. The many years of faithfully teaching and preaching is yeilding dividends! It's wonderful to see each church growing in hospitality as they rotate which one will host these different events. We continue to pray for wisdom on how to lead these faithful followers of Jesus, and also for laborers to be sent into the harvest.
