Submission to The Skeena Salmon Arts Festival **Downtown Banner Project**

The Skeena Salmon Arts Festival welcomes image submissions from artists for **banners** to be displayed in the Terrace downtown area from July 2026 to July 2027.

As the artist, you will retain the original artwork and all rights. Successful applicants will receive \$200 for the use of their image. Banners are planned to be sold to the public, in a manner yet to be determined with all funds going to the Skeena Salmon Arts Fest Society. The Skeena Salmon Arts Fest retains the right to use the banner image for future promotion of Fest activities.

Submission Guidelines

The printed banners will be 30"x 60", with digital artwork printed in a 24"w X 48"h frame. Your submitted digital artwork should be 2 high: 1 wide dimensions. Please consider this aspect ratio carefully when you submit, as we won't be able to select images that do not display well in this 2:1 ratio. Please also consider that the images are displayed on light standards, to be viewed briefly by motorists and admired at a distance by pedestrians. Artwork that is bold and brightly coloured will present well on banners. A sample banner is attached, showing our planned layout.

Artists are encouraged to interpret the Skeena salmon theme broadly and creatively.

Digital images of all mediums are eligible for submission – sculpture, clay, glass, fibre, photography, painting, jewelry and beyond.

All artwork must be of high calibre, and display a good understanding of the medium. Artwork must be the original creation of the artist. **Art from last year's Skeena Salmon Art Show or other previously shown work may be submitted.**

You will be contacted by the committee if you are successful in having your art accepted for the 2024 intake. If selected, you will be responsible for providing a high resolution digital image (5000x8000 pixels) for print production, or submitting original artwork for photography by a professional.
