

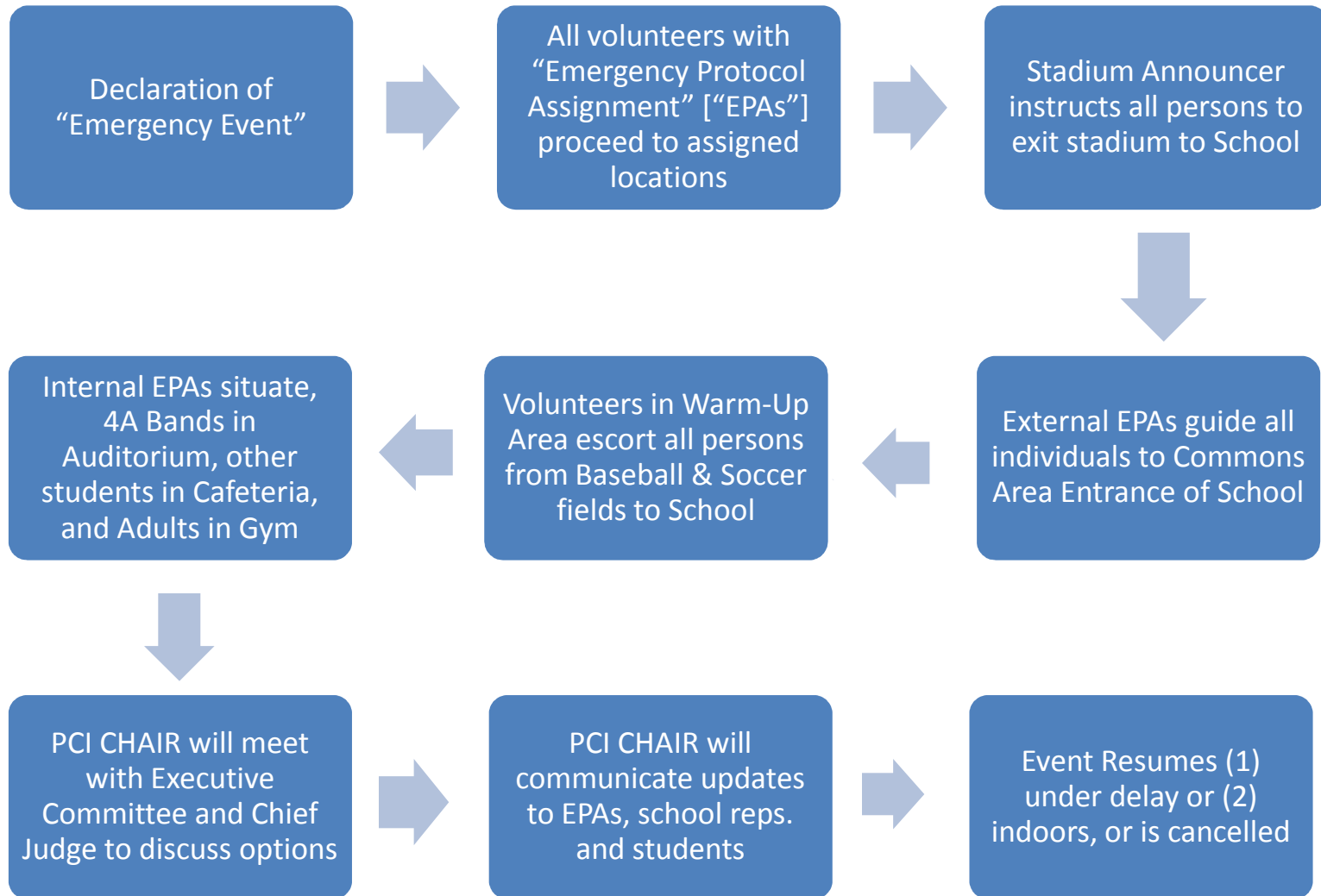
EMERGENCY EVENT Protocols

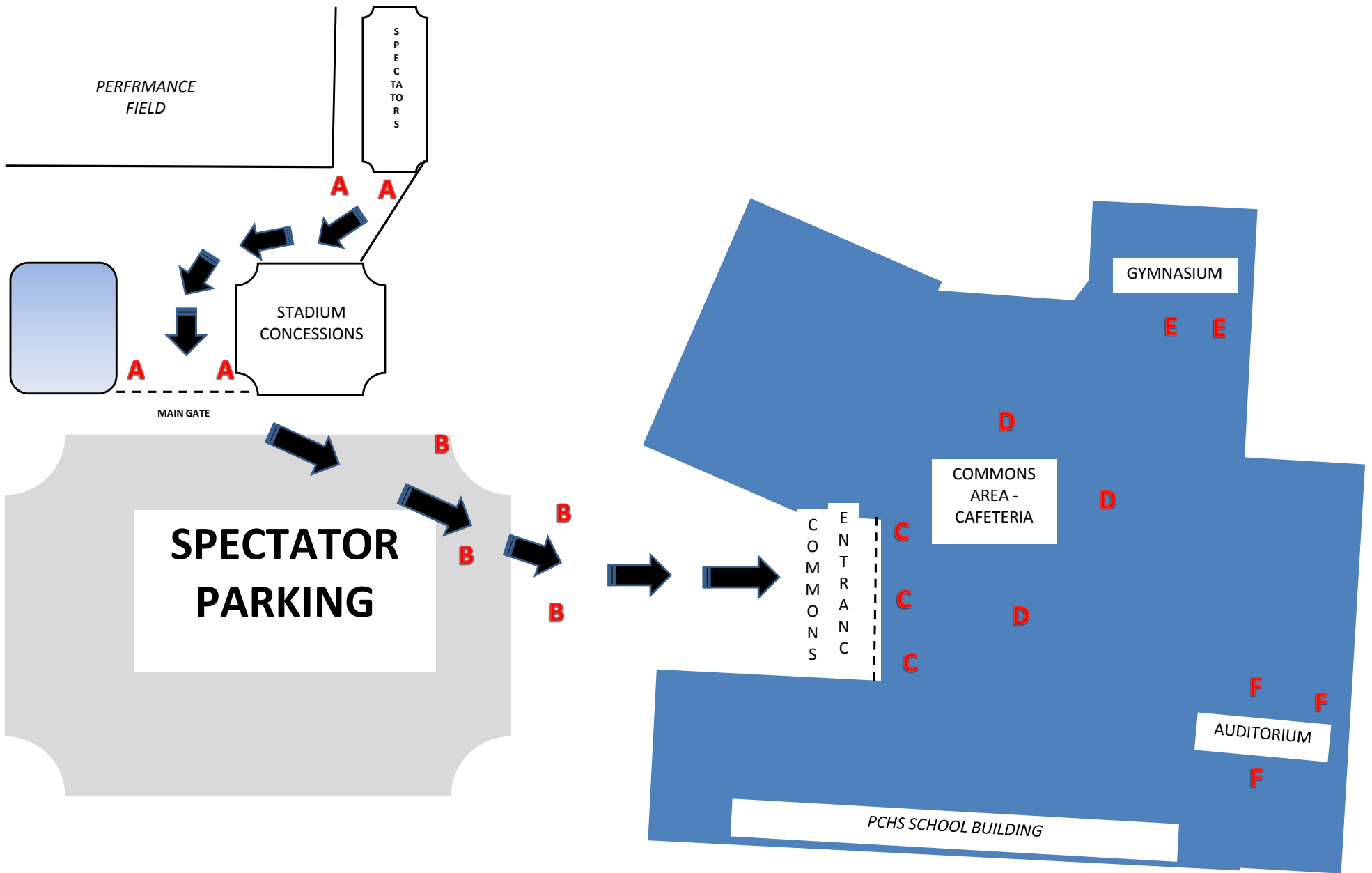
- Upon declaration by the PCI Executive Committee of an “Emergency Event”, PCI activities may be SUSPENDED.
- PCI Chair will meet with Executive Committee, PCHS Band Director, and Chief Judge to evaluate duration of event suspension, revised performance schedule, or (if nec.) cancellation
- See “Emergency Event Protocol” Flowchart for predetermined actions and responsibilities

“EMERGENCY EVENT” defined

- ① EXCESSIVE HEAT..... *“AccuWeather” Heat Index > 90 deg.*
- ② HEAVY RAIN/WIND..... *Bands, equipment and patrons are endangered*
- ③ SEVERE STORM..... *Local Lightening Strikes, Hurricane, Tornado*
- ④ OTHER..... *Terrorist or other endangering incident*
