Funding Diversity and Impact Event in Beverly Hills Tackles Diversity, Equity, Inclusion (DEI) and Entrepreneurship BY AVA V. MANUEL ON MAY 8, 2023

Beverly Hills, CA - On May 1st, 2023, the Funding Diversity and Impact event was held at O'Melveny and Myers LLP in Beverly Hills, attracting a wide range of high-caliber founders and investors. The event was co-hosted by Axel Tillman and Kaustav Chaudhuri, Co-founders and Entrepreneurs in Residence (EIR) of Pitch Global, a global platform for investors and entrepreneurs.

The Funding Diversity and Impact opened with a keynote speech by Trish Halamandaris, Director of UCLA Anderson Venture Accelerator, who spoke on the topic of Female Entrepreneurship. Halamandaris presented statistics highlighting the significantly lower number of women founders accessing startup funding and the lower amount they apply for compared to their male counterparts. She encouraged women founders to educate themselves and reach out for mentorship to gain access to investor funds and grants available to women starting their businesses.

The event also showcased three DEI projects that aim to level the playing field for marginalized communities:

The California Inclusivity Fund presented by Axel Tillman, Co-founder and EIR at Pitch Global, aims to address the significant disadvantage faced by Black, Latino, and Women Entrepreneurs in obtaining funding. Tillman and Chaudhuri are Investment Directors in the California Inclusivity Fund, working with private/public partnerships to raise \$100M for the Fund.



Chris Horton, Founder of the New Business Equity Project (NBEP), presented the National Black Entrepreneurs Project (NBEP), a new initiative aimed at helping Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) individuals acquire existing businesses instead of starting from scratch. The initiative, called "quantifiers," aims to increase the chances of success for marginalized communities and support local economies by preserving jobs and taxes.

Rachel Carlsen, founder of the CPA-led 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization Create Impact, discussed how to create an organization with minimal mistakes and learning curves.

Carlsen's speech emphasized the ability to create an impact and make a difference in the world, and she shared anecdotes from her childhood, including her first company at nine years old and a candy company at thirteen. Carlsen's nonprofit organization aims to empower socially conscious entrepreneurs, humanitarians, and nonprofit organizations by acting as fiscal sponsor and social impact partner.

Other presentations included **IBM's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Program** by *Samir Mehta* and **How to Create Impact in Emerging Markets** by *Newton Paskin*, the former Head of LATAM. Paskin emphasized creating impact through diversity and promoting inclusion for all stakeholders, and he highlighted the importance of responsible capitalism.

The event also featured a very insightful interview conducted by **O'Melveny & Myers (OMM)** Partner *Nate Gallon* with the Head of **NGK Capital** *Thomas Kluz*.
