HODGEMAN COUNTY- The Hodgeman County Health Department has been notified of a local business being considered a COVID-19 outbreak location by KDHE standards. This business is the Pride Ag Resources, Haston branch.

Those who have went to Pride Ag at Hanston beginning on 10/26/2020 to the present have been potentially exposed to COVID-19. Those who have went to Pride Ag on any of these dates should monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days from the last day they were at Pride Ag.

The symptoms that should be monitored for include fever, cough, chills, muscle aches, sore throat, new loss of smell or taste, fatigue, diarrhea, shortness of breath, and/or difficulty breathing. If symptoms develop, please stay home and contact your health care provider or the local health department for guidance regarding testing. In an emergency, please call 911 and notify first responders that you were potentially exposed to COVID-19 and, if possible, be wearing a face mask when they arrive.
