## Kansas Adopts CDC's Guidance on Mask-Wearing, Physical Distance

TOPEKA - The following statement can be attributed to Governor Laura Kelly regarding the CDC's latest guidance for fully-vaccinated individuals:

"Effective immediately, Kansas will adopt the CDC's latest guidance that fully-vaccinated Kansans are no longer required to wear masks indoors or outdoors or physically distance, except in circumstances such as those required by businesses, public transportation, or health care facilities.
