
Happy 5th Anniversary

Pastor Pat's Corner

Psalm 34:18: The Lord is close to the brokenhearted.

Brokenness hurts. The feeling of brokenness rearranges how we feel and process our emotions and how we view the world through the lens of pain and disillusionment. We experience brokenness in various ways, through the loss of loved ones, divorce, broken friendships, job loss, and betrayal of trust. No matter the cause, brokenness is uncomfortable. It makes us question everything, everyone, and sometimes even God. We tend to look at the pain and horror of brokenness, but we neglect to look for the lessons or blessings in our circumstances. Instead of focusing on the "why" of the situation, try meditating on its benefits. For some of you, this is challenging to do. You probably ask, "How can I find blessings or joy in losing a loved one? How do I find joy when my marriage falls apart? How do I trust anyone again when my trust has been broken? The answer is simple. Look at what you have experienced: unconditional love and the value of being in a relationship where you are valued and appreciated. You had the joy of building a life and raising children with someone you cherished. You have had an opportunity to work with good people—and some not-sogood people. Overall, you have had beautiful experiences; life has not been a complete dumpster fire. God has been with us in good times and bad. Every ending starts a new beginning, and we must remember that as people of faith, we do not walk alone or by sight. God walks with us, and we walk by faith. We cannot avoid brokenness no matter the reason, but we can heal and grow from it. Healing is a journey that starts with one step: knowing God walks with us.
