Treasurer's Report:

Master Financial Statement 2022/2023

- Nothing has changed in future budget 2025
- General fund budget has been submitted to DOLA and approves
- YTD actuals have changed \$601,000
 - Due to a discrepancy in the County Nox. Weed contribution
- Waiting on one reimbursement for the VF project that will be forwarded to VENCE (for 2024 collars/subscriptions) once received
- Moving into the future continue to track expenses and keep all receipts

CSAFE-

Statewide investment pool approved for local government entities (similar ColoTrust)

- Favorable interest rates compared to banks,
- Very secure,
- ColoTrust- not as reliable/secure in Ken's opinion
- CSAFE- more flexible, high quality
