

Hampshire Rose Criteria

The Hampshire Rose is awarded to Leaders, Commissioners and Appointment Holders in recognition of service to the County of Hampshire West. It is not to be regarded as a long service award. Recipients will have completed at least 30 years service in guiding, of which at least 15 years must be in the County of Hampshire West and will either:

- Have attained age 65 years
- Left service

The HR is presented by the County Commissioner or her representative and should not be presented at the same time as long service or any other awards.

The Hampshire Rose brooch is not normally worn in uniform unless the recipient is attending a HR function or has been invited to a Guiding event in their capacity as a Leader or Commissioner.

A recipient would normally be living in Hampshire at the time of receiving the award. If at some point in the future they move away from the County they will continue to receive invitations to the lunch and other guiding events.

Receiving the HR does not prevent members undertaking other roles in Guiding for which they are eligible.

Decisions regarding this award will be made on an individual basis. The decision of the County Commissioner is final.
