When you complete a module, your Unit Leader will sign this off and verify it onto your GO account. When you have completed 4 modules you will be presented with your 'Discovering Leadership' badge. You can then continue on your YLDP and complete further modules, achieving 'Exploring Leadership' for 8 modules and 'Empowering Leadership' for all 12 modules.

The YLDP is designed to help you to develop leadership skills and learn from experiences. When you turn 18yrs old, please discuss with your unit what role you would like to continue in – Unit Leader or Leader in Training. Your Unit leader will provide your commissioner with a letter of commendation and then your Division will arrange a DBS to be completed and you need to complete your Safe Space Level 1 and 2 via the Learning Platform.
