

Hampshire Rose Criteria

The Hampshire Rose is awarded to Leaders, Commissioners and Appointment Holders in recognition of service to the county of Hampshire West. It is not to be regarded as a long service award.

To qualify for this award, the prospective recipient must meet the following criteria:

- Have completed a minimum of 30 year's service in Girlguiding
- Have completed 15 year's service in Hampshire West
- Have either reached age 65 years or left Girlguiding

The recipient would normally be living in Hampshire West at the time of receiving the award. If they then move away from the county, they will continue to receive invitations to the Hampshire Rose Lunch.

The Hampshire Rose is presented by the County Commissioner or her representative. The Hampshire Rose brooch is normally worn when attending a Hampshire Rose function or a Girlguiding event.

Decisions regarding this award will be made on an individual basis. The decision of the County Commissioner is final.
