### **School Applications 2023**





### **Parents Questionnaires**

Thank you everyone that has returned their parent questionnaire, we have had some great feedback, if you haven't returned your questionnaire and would like to, please post it in the box in our porch area or hand it to a member of staff. We will use these questionaries to reflect on our practice and make improvements to the service we provide.

### **Observation Checkpoint/ Parents Meetings**

As we have reduced the amount of observations we put on tapestry to spend time extending on your child's learning as it happens rather than spending time recording and planning for their next steps. We have recently introduced observation checkpoints where will record a short summary to make sure your child is on track and invite you to a meeting to share their progress. These are completed at 6,12, 18 and 24 months and at 3, 3.5 and 4 years of age. Your child will still have a two-year check between the ages of 2 and 3 years. We will still assess your child on an ongoing basis, although these wont always be recorded, your child's keyworker will be happy to discuss your child's progress at any time.

#### The Baby Room

Over the past month we have enjoyed going on Autumn walks to the park and practicing our balance and climbing skill as well as collecting autumn leaves. We then used our leaves to explore with paint, feeling the different textures and developing our fine motor skills. We have enjoyed filling and emptying container and have made some autumn sensory bottles. We explored our new sensory room and have played outside in the garden climbing onto the bikes and drawing with the chalks.





#### The Toddler Room

In the Toddler room the children have been exploring Autumn materials which they collected at home in their Autumn treasure bags, we then explored these material in different textures such as making marks with sticks in gloop and poking sticks into playdough. We have also explored the bark area outside and crunched our feet in the Autumn leaves.

The children have also shown a lot of interest in books particularly the animals sounds book and have enjoyed pressing the sound buttons and lifting the flaps. Adventure Bear has been going on his holidays to some of the children's homes and its great to see what he has been up to.

#### **Early Learner Room**

The Early Learners have recently been interested in autumn and have been crunching in the autumn leaves outside. Everyone has taken their autumn treasure bags and scavenger hunts home and have came back to nursery to share their exciting finds and explore these in the tuff tray. The children have collected leaves, conkers, acorns and sticks to make their autumn pictures. The children have shown a particular fascination with touch and feel books and have enjoyed feeling the different textures, we have added these to our lending library for children to enjoy at home. We have enjoyed activities such as ice play with dinosaurs and talking about textures and if it feels cold.





#### Pre-School

The past month in pre-school we have enjoyed welcoming our friends from Early Learners. We have also spent some time talking about our families and who lives in our homes. Some children have been interested in the human body and we have expended on this by looking at our skeletal system and the different bones in our bodies. We have enjoyed circle time where we have been focussing on body percussion and rhythm and rhyme. We had a walk to our local church to see Nicola the room manager of Early Learner after she got married, and have created a new breakfast and snack station to promote children's independence and they have been very good at serving themselves.
