



Housetraining Protocol

The key to successful housetraining is in being able to predict when your puppy needs to eliminate

When you are home

- Place puppy in crate with stuffed chew toy
- At every hour, bring puppy to the potty area. Wait for 3 min.
- If puppy eliminates, reward with 3 pieces of freeze dried liver. If puppy doesn't eliminate, put puppy back in crate for another 30 min and try again.
- When puppy eliminates and is empty, play with them in the playpen or let them explore other parts of the house. Keep this to a maximum of 10 minutes. We don't want the puppy to get to the point of having to eliminate again while they are exploring.
- Return puppy back into crate and repeat the same at the next hour.

When you are not able to supervise

- Leave puppy in play pen with chew toys, bowl of water, their crate (left open) and their potty area.

When do puppies eliminate?

- When they wake up
- After they eat
- After they play
