## **Building / Grounds:**



- (Updated) Discussed expanding the Board members since we expect some turnover in the next few years. Dave Murray and Don Schneider have been added to the Board as of the March 12<sup>th</sup> Board meeting.
- (No Update) Discussed lead reclamation from pistol range will be done in April. We will reach out to Tom N. as he built the machine. It was mentioned that we may move the old sand out and put new sand in.
