



August 4, 2025 Monthly Meeting Minutes Hope Rod & Gun Club Hope Rod And Gun Clubhouse

The 715th meeting of the Hope Rod and Gun Club monthly meeting was called to order at 6:31 pm by President Deese.

Secretary's Report:

President Deese asked if there were any corrections or questions to the July 2025 monthly meeting minutes emailed to each member and posted on the club website. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to accept the July 2025 minutes. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer George presented the July 2025 Income and Expense Report. He asked if there were any questions on the presented Income and Expense Report. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to accept the July 2025 Income and Expense Report as presented. A motion was made and seconded to approve the Income and Expense Reports. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Building / Grounds:

- (New) Need to replace the furnace before winter. We will obtain a quote prior to the next meeting.
- (New) All of the used brass casings have been separated from all casing buckets and will be taken to get recycled. The club usually makes several hundred dollars on used brass. Thanks to the members that helped complete this project.
- (Updated) Jay will run the new lighting project for the Trap / Skeet field. Jim Binger has
 estimated costs for new lighting. Dave Muray did not have a chance to follow up on the lights.
 Deerfield has recently installed new lights. Dave will follow up with Deerfield on their lighting
 project.
- (Updated) Lead reclamation in pistol range project. Looking for someone to lead this project.
 We need to put together a team of volunteers to keep this project going. Tom Nelson is available to help.
- (No Update) Jeff, from Interstate Partners, which are developing the land east of the club, canceled coming to the July meeting due to them working with the new village Board. He will let us know when he has more updated information to share.
- (No Update) We received a quote from Capital Security for installing and maintaining key cards.
 The quote was around \$20k. We will be contacting additional vendors.
- (No Update) Continued discussing fencing in the entire gun club for safety reasons. More discussions will follow.
- (No Update) Looking into a DNR grant for installing a fence around the club. President Deese will be looking into the annual hours we are open to the public.

Old Business:

- (No Update) Discussed the need for a place to sell outdoor equipment, firearms, and other items online.
- (No Update) Discussed researching a five stand for trap range. Will ask for volunteers when we are ready to discuss further.
- (No Update) President Deese will follow-up with Casey on finishing the driveway.
- (No Update) Discussed a new award for person(s) that volunteers the most during the year.
- (No Update) Discussed holding a raffle this year if we receive our non-profit status.

New business:

- (New) Trap I was down due to a broken wire which has now been repaired.





- (Updated) RSO training is scheduled for Saturday September 13th. Just a reminder, we expect you to work as an RSO for a few Sundays during the year when we are open to the public.
