

August 7, 2023 Monthly Meeting Minutes Hope Rod & Gun Club

The 693rd meeting of the Hope Rod and Gun Club monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Deese.

Secretary's Report: President Deese asked if there were any corrections or questions to the July 2023 monthly meeting minutes emailed to each member. President Deese asked for a motion to accept the July 2023 minutes. A motion was made and seconded to accept and approve the July 2023 minutes. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Discussed putting a five-stand on the trap field. More discussion will take place.

- Clocks have been installed in the rifle and pistol ranges.


Old Business:
