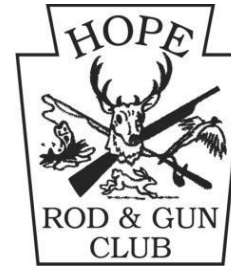
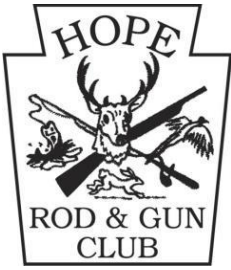
Fishing / Hunting Report:

- There was a discussion about RSO training at the club. Three members indicated that they would like the training. A committee will follow up to determine how many members would like RSO training.

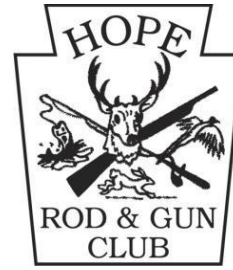
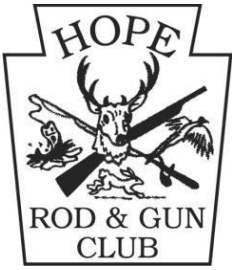
New business:
