#### **WELCOME to IMMANUEL LUTHERAN CHURCH**

A Prayer Upon Entering Church - Almighty God, to whom all creation gives thanks and praises You for fulfilling all Your ancient promises in sending my Savior to rescue me, grant me such joy that it overflows my thoughts and words into joyful acts of devotion to You and in service to the people around me; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, my Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

AS WE GATHER - We do not often emphasize the psalms during the Advent season, instead being eager to read about the prophecies, anticipating Jesus' coming. Yet the psalms are God's Word during terrible times to people who lived before God's promises were fulfilled in our Savior's coming. This Advent we have focused on several psalms as we use them to prepare to celebrate our Lord's birth with open eyes and ears. The traditional psalm for Christmas Day, Psalm 98, is a psalm of rejoicing. Sing to the Lord a new song! This is a day for praising God, rejoicing with one another, and spreading the joy to all whom we meet!

- C Amen.





Luke 2:1-14

1 And it came to pass in those days that a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. 2 This census first took place while Quirinius was governing Syria. 3 So all went to be registered, everyone to his own city.

4 Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, 5 to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child. 6 So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. 7 And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

8 Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. 9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around

them, and they were greatly afraid. 10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. 11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. 12 And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger."

13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying:

- 14 "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"

- C Praise to You, O Christ.


#### NICENE CREED

All I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.



# **PRAYER OF THE CHURCH** Luke 2:1, 4, 6, 8, 11, 19


- P On this joyful day, let us go to God in prayer for all people in their various needs. "In those days a decree went out."


#### THE WORDS OF OUR LORD






