



Helen Twenhafel Vogel, 101 years old passed away to be with our Lord Saturday, May 15, 2021 at T.L.C. Assistant Living in Harlingen, Texas. She was a lifelong resident of Mercedes, Texas born April 29, 1920 in Mercedes, Texas. Helen is survived by her son Donald (Shirley) Vogel of Mercedes; daughter Lynn Vogel Davis of Houston; and her beloved sister in-law Mildred Twenhafel of Mercedes. She has seven grandchildren and thirteen great-grand children including many nieces and nephews.

Preceded in death by her husband Herbert E. Vogel married for 58 years; her parents Albert & Katherine Brixen Twenhafel; her daughter Carol Vogel Pace and son in-law Kemp Pace of Longmont, Colorado; her son in-law Ray Davis of Houston; her brother Erwin Twenhafel of Mercedes; and her sister Kathleen Petrone of Tennessee.

Mrs. Vogel graduated from Mercedes High School in 1938. On June 7, 1939 she married Herbert E. Vogel where they made their home near Mercedes, Texas; they engaged in agriculture and grew citrus, vegetables, cotton, and started the first Red Brangus cattle ranching in the Rio Grande Valley. She was active with her husband in the Red Brangus Association and the Rio Grande Valley Old Machinery Club and American Legion. Helen received the Mercedes Chamber of Commerce Lifetime Service award in 2002.

Raising her children in a Christian life she also taught this to other children in Sunday school and Vacation Bible School. For more than 60 years, Mrs. Vogel has been a Dorcus Society Member serving in all the offices. She was a lifetime member/historian at Immanuel Lutheran Church where services will be held.
