Small Groups Subjects

Does proposition of starting a mentoring program or being a part of a mentoring program in your church overwhelm you? There might be many reasons for this. You didn't have a mentor so you don't even really know what it looks like. You've never mentored anybody you wouldn't even know where to begin. I don't feel I'm mature enough or I don't know enough of the Bible. Whatever the reason the question is this where do I start? How do you start to establish a mentoring environment in your church? I first saw the phrase mentoring environment. In an article. I read I think it was from a life magazine. I remember thinking that's it. It can't be just a program. It has to start with establishing availability from the mentors and teachability for the mentees.

Starting Point: Prayer

Start with praying for yourself. Pray for a heart that really cares about the women in your church and if they are established in the faith. Then pray about finding some other women in your church that have a heart to see women established in the faith.

With the group of ladies that you've reached out to start to pray that God would raise up mentors and give the younger women a desire to be a mentee. In order to be mentored you a teachable heart.

In order to be a mentor you must learn to love what God loves. You must be willing to be available. You must learn to lean in and listen. Not just with your ears but with your heart. It is Gods desire that each of us are to be established in our faith. Seeing younger women established in their fate, should be your consuming desire.

Then pray that the Lord would plant and grow a desire in the hearts of the women in your church to be a part of mentoring commitment. People don't necessarily respond to a program but to a purpose, a calling.

All of the above starts with prayer. Individual and corporate prayer.

Start with the women who have been praying with you about this as your first set of mentors. Start a weekly or monthly class for them to attend on how to do this.

Solidify: Call, Process & Walk.

Start by teaching (Titus 2:3-4). Then teach them what question to use in order to get the ball rolling. They main thing is to learn about your mentee. Who are they? Why are they here? What do they need? Where are they in their faith journey?

Start by sharing your personal testimony. Then ask them what their story is. Sometimes I have them write it out. Make sure they truly understand the gospel and have excepted it for themselves.

Self Evaluation: Learning to enjoy being who you are.

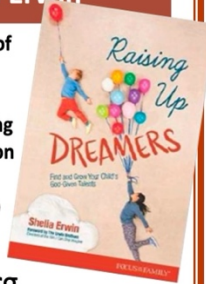
