## Everybody's Talking

**Strange sight:** People looking out their kitchen windows in northern Scotland usually don't expect to see a monkey in their yards. But Carl Nagle, a resident of Kincaig, saw just that. A monkey was by the fence, eating nuts that had fallen from the birdfeeder. Nagle observed that the monkey looked as though he knew he shouldn't have been there. The little fellow turned out to be an escapee from the Highland Wildlife Park, where a troop of 37 Japanese macaques, also known as snow monkeys, make their home. Ernie's owners saw it, and soon the bird was reunited with his best friend, Lottie. Now the two are back to their old antics, with Ernie perching on Lottie's back for free rides.

She set the record with a blast that reached 44.1 decibels. ## Recipe of the month

### Favourite Barbecued Chicken

2 broiler/fryer chickens (3 to 4 pounds each), cut into 8 pieces each	1/4 cup lemon juice
Salt and pepper	2 tablespoons brown sugar
<b>Barbecue Sauce:</b>	2 tablespoons water
2 tablespoons canola oil	1 teaspoon ground mustard
2 small onions, finely chopped	1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
2 cups ketchup	1/4 teaspoon pepper
	1/8 teaspoon salt
	1/8 teaspoon hot pepper sauce

Prep Time: 15 min Grill Time: 35 min Yield: 12 servings

- 1 Sprinkle chicken pieces with salt and pepper. Grill, skin side down, uncovered, on a greased rack over medium heat for 20 minutes.
- 2 Meanwhile, in a small saucepan, make barbecue sauce by heating oil over medium heat. Add onion; sauté until tender. Stir in remaining sauce ingredients and bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer, uncovered, for 10 minutes.
- 3 Turn chicken; brush with barbecue sauce. Grill 15-25 minutes longer, brushing frequently with sauce, until a thermometer reads 165° when inserted in the breast and 170°-175° in the thigh.
