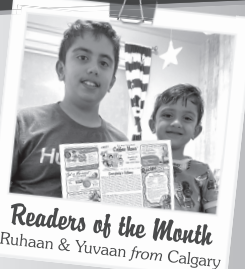

Dress dilemma: A groom's absentminded mistake led to disaster when he accidentally left his fiancée's \$2,000 (USD) wedding dress on the car roof and then drove away, leaving the dress to fly off the vehicle. Strawberry Frozen Yogurt

Ingredients

- 1 lb - 1 pound fresh strawberries
- half - lemon, juiced
- 2 - (7 ounce) containers Greek yogurt
- 3/4 cup - white sugar



RECIPE PREPARATION

1. Blend strawberries and lemon juice together in a blender until smooth; refrigerate until cold, about 1 hour.
2. Stir yogurt and sugar into strawberry mixture until well blended and smooth; pour mixture into ice cream machine's container.
3. Freeze according to manufacturer's directions for a soft-serve consistency.
