Foster/Lamb Neonatal and Pediatric Award

Purpose:

To honor an individual who has contributed to the neonatal/pediatric respiratory therapy community in the State of Missouri.

Award:

Recipients of this award will be announced at the MSRC annual meeting and will receive a specially engraved plaque and cash award. If the recipient is unable to attend, their award will be sent to them.

Criteria for Selection:

Nominees for the Foster/Lamb Neonatal/Pediatric Award should exhibit qualities of leadership and service to the respiratory therapy community in the state of Missouri. The nominee must be a member of the Missouri Society for Respiratory Care and the American Association for Respiratory Care. The individual's service should be at least 5 years in the field and reflect contributions above and beyond normal expectations with a minimum of 2 years in the Neonatal/Pediatric field.

Nominations:

Nominations may be made by any MSRC member and submitted to the award committee via email or may be submitted using the online form at www.mosrc.org

Nominations must include the following:

- Name, address, telephone number of person submitting the nomination
- Name and address of nominee
- Current title
- NPS credential, preferred
- Current organization affiliation
- Brief summary of nominee's respiratory career
- A summary of contributions by the nominee to the respiratory care community
- Other information or recognition relative to outstanding service
- Years of employment (at least 5 years' experience)
- Letter from Supervisor/Manager/Director confirming nominee is in good standing at their organization.
- Nominations should be in word document format, double-spaced, two pages or less and must be received by the review committee no later than April 1 of the award year.

Submission: submit all nominations, prior to April 1, to the Foster/Lamb Neonatal Pediatric Award Committee (the selection committee is composed of the two Director's at Large of the Missouri Society of Respiratory Care.
