Dracul History

Ethnicity

- Dracul holds many ethnicities, but the most relevant is Romanian. Others include Russian and German. Dracul was founded in memory of Vlad III, also known in popular society as Dracula.

Icons

- Since Dracul holds majority Romanian Heritage, other members of Romanian society are important as well. Russian members including Saint Nicholas II of Russia are the Patron Saint of Dracul.

Foundation/Location

Commonwealth of Dracul was founded on September 25, 2017, in Clear Lake Houston, Texas. The area claimed is approximately 111.46 acres, located within the Sylvan Rodriguez Park. The Capital of Dracul is Bran District, which is a federal district.

Dmitri Howie, along with Stephen Luke and Mark Millner were the initial Founding Fathers of Dracul. They envisioned a nation that could be ran without corruption, justice for all citizens, a better infrastructure, and congress, they eventually referred to as “parliament”.

Throughout time, Kassie Bushong was added as the first Founding Mother, following the most recent Founding Father Bruce Cooper.

Special Events/Dates

May 9, Victory Day: In April of 2018, a small group of Draculian Citizens had a disagreement with the government over the treatment of religious citizens. The small group voiced that the religious peoples should be targeted, imprisoned, and killed by the Dracul Intelligence Agency. The Federal Government did not take kindly to this proposal and prohibited the small group's attempt at singling out religious peoples. The small group eventually formed in April of 2018, under the name of "Dracul Confederacy" and attempted to take control of the Capitol in North Dracul.

By May 9th, the small group had eventually disbanded and were declared "defeated" by the Federal Government. The leader of the Group, Al Fare, was banned from the community and had his citizenship revoked.

Flag Details



The Flag of the Commonwealth of Dracul is a symbol of freedom and liberty to which Draculians pledge their allegiance by standing at attention, facing the flag with their right hand over the heart, and reciting:

"My allegiance to the flag of Dracul, is for the republic, which stands for everyone. A nation protected by God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."

The flag consists of 3 alternating white, red and blue stripes that represent the nation, and a dragon, representing the Order of the Dragon. The bird represents the 7 castles of Wallachia, while the cross represents Orthodoxy.

The colors on the flag represent:

- Red: valor and bravery
- White: purity and innocence
- Blue: vigilance, perseverance, and justice

Specialty Flags

- The Chancellor is represented by the Chancellor's Standard. The flag is blue, with 2 red stripes, one top, one bottom. A shield is pictured in the center, with an ouroboros, spinning sun, and bird.
- Please note: According to Dracul's suggestion, when a Draculian flag appears worn or otherwise no longer appropriate for display, it should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning.
