Voices" by Jeanie Crane, is a compilation of thoughts of members at that time, and many who are still members. Jeanie asked the question: "What are some of your first experiences with Network?" Here is one written by Taylor Stephens-Parker:

I believe I joined in early 1981, a long time ago. I'd read a little in the paper and I'd been holding on to this article for about six months, and finally, I said, "You know, I just ought to go," because I was a new graduate from UTA, just had my master's in psych and community mental health, and I was a therapist at MHMR at the new clinic. I was a single parent to three kids, just been divorced since September, and really felt the need to have some adult that I wasn't trying to help cure, just to talk to. When I went for the first time, that room was full, and I mean I was terrified! The first person I remember was Ann Marek. She had a very booming voice. You could hear her all the way to the front of Ol' South Pancake House, and there were a lot people there who really didn't have booming voices, and really, you had a hard time hearing everything that they said, and she would stand up and say "SPEAK FROM THE DIAPHRAGM!" and I thought, "I'm not really going to do it. I'm not really an executive woman." I was terrified, anyway, because I wasn't really used to standing up and saying who I was. It was just amazing to me, that there were these people here doing such different things. And I didn't—I never even thought of all those different choices to myself, didn't even know that they existed. So for me, it was really and awakening.
