- **DAY HIGH-POINTS (GRAND & RESERVE)** High-Point cost is \$5 per category.
- **WEEKEND HIGH-POINTS**
- *Non-NC approved class
- Ribbons and tickets (used for raffle prizes) for 1st-6th placings.
- **Current Negative Coggins Copy REQUIRED**
- \$10 trailer fee if tying to trailer OR
- Stalls available: \$30 day/\$35 per night
- Camping \$25 per night with electric hookup
- Camping \$15 per night without electric
- Bedding \$9 a bag or bring your own
- No arrivals before 5:00 pm on Friday night. You must inform us if you are arriving Friday and your estimated time.
- Show clothes required. No bling required.
- Helmets encouraged for riders under 18.
- Leadline and Tiny Tot may cross enter classes if 7 & under.
- Per NC rules – Tiny Tot may cross into Childrens. Senior Senior may cross enter to Senior.
- Tiny Tots are automatically Novice.
- NC Novice – less than 60 NC points, not a trainer, does not show breed shows. Check if your name is on the list. You don't have to be a member to be on the list. If you show at an NC show your points start to accumulate.
- **No refunds for scratched classes once the show has started.**
- Riders may cross enter Ranch classes and Western Pleasure. Ranch is judged based on forward movement.
- English Showmanship should use a flat leather, solid nylon, or bridle with no bling of any.
- **Preregistration for classes is required to be filled out online before Thursday, July 4th** to help free up the registration booth in the morning. Must bring Coggins & money the day of.
- **To reserve a stall please fill out the preregistration form.**
- You can register that day but are not guaranteed a stall.
