

My Veteran's Arm Nonprofit Partners with Pentagon Federal Credit Union in Gloves and Socks Campaign

Local Nonprofit Launches Gloves and Socks Campaign to Support Community Members in Need



BriefingWire.com, 2/01/2026 - Lorton, Virginia – My Veteran's Arm (MVA) Inc., a local nonprofit organization has announced the launch of a new campaign dedicated to providing gloves and socks for individuals and families in need. With winter temperatures dropping, the initiative aims to address a critical shortage of warm clothing essentials among vulnerable populations, and those experiencing homelessness.

Since partnering with the Pentagon Federal Credit Union (PFCU), the nonprofit's "Gloves and Socks Campaign" has collected over 200 items from donors across the region. Collection bins have been set up in the Pentagon Federal Credit Union at Fort Belvoir, Virginia making it easy for residents to contribute. The campaign will run from December 31, 2025, through February 7, 2026, with all donated items distributed directly to those in need, and to local shelters and outreach programs.

"Winter can be a difficult time for many families," said Colonel (retired) Dr. Mary Gillam, the nonprofit's founder and CEO. "Something as simple as a pair of warm gloves or socks can make a huge difference. We are grateful for the community's continued generosity and support."

Last year, MVA sponsored groceries for military facing food insecurity, and provided food to local food banks. MVA also provided coats and blankets for those in need. In January, the nonprofit recently conducted an in-depth training webinar for those looking to transition from the military.

About the Nonprofit: My Veteran's Arm, commonly referred to as MVA is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt nonprofit organization providing veterans and their families with resources, information, training, and development services that contribute to improving the lives of those who served.
