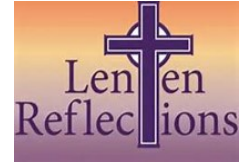

Area Catholic Community Update: Perhaps some of you have already seen or heard about the letter from Bishop Donald Kettler regarding Area Catholic Communities. In it he says that he, in consultation with the diocesan planning office, priests, and lay leaders, has finalized the plan for Area Catholic Communities (ACCs) in the Diocese of St. Cloud. There have been changes and updates since the draft was originally released to the public last November. The bishop's letter and the map of all the ACCs in the diocese can be found at the website for the diocesan planning office: <http://planning.stedio.org/> You can also expect to see this and more in an upcoming issue of The Central Minnesota Catholic magazine (the new Visitor format that hopefully you are receiving). There have been no major changes for our cluster. Sacred Heart and St. Lawrence will join St. Henry's and Holy Cross in an Area Catholic Community as we had recommended and anticipated. The next steps will involve formally naming an ACC planning council that will be asked to go through some training by the diocese to help them form a vision for the ACC and recommend a process to bring that vision to completion. Every ACC is different, and the timetable and recommendations in each location will reflect that difference. The diocese is giving us the flexibility to creatively engineer our own plan and schedule for implementation. Watch for more information in the upcoming bulletins. May God bless us all as we go through these changes and help us to always grow in what matters most. *Fr. George*
