The Common Thread of Holy Saturday: How a Trauma Lens Can Unite and Strengthen our Catholic Church

Many people spend Holy Saturday by getting ready for Easter Sunday which reflects our overall unease with trauma on Good Friday. Trauma and its aftermath are viewed as something to "get over" as soon as possible. We forget: the resurrected Christ still carried his wounds. This presentation will explore the aftermath of trauma, and how use of a trauma lens can serve as powerful witness. We will discuss pastoral responses that help or hurt and will close with a look at what a trauma-responsive Catholic Church might look like.




St. Cloud 40 Days for Life Wednesday, February 17 – **Sunday, March 28, 2021**
