

Fun Fair Update-The website is up and running for our Fun Fair Auctions. Here is how it works. https://givergy.us/sthenrys2021 to get into the website. There will also be a link on our school's website at www.sthenrysareaschool.com. On the left hand side of the main auction page, you will see a tab called "Silent Auction" Items." Click that and all of our silent auction items will appear. To bid on an item, just click on the blue button that says how much the current bid is. It will then direct you to a bid page, which will confirm your bid. The first time you do this, it will ask for your credit card information. The credit card will not be charged a thing unless you win the item(s). If this is a struggle, you can always call me at the school at 346-6190, and I can bid for you or help you out. The auctions open for bidding on Sunday, April 11th at 8 AM and close on Sunday, April 18th at 3:00 PM. Items are visible prior to the start of the auction. Also along the side, there is a "Make a Donation" tab. Realizing that we are unable to have the games, food, special raffles, etc., if you'd like to just make a straight donation, there are buttons to push to do so.
