






Prayer to the Holy Spirit

O God, in your infinite wisdom you have called us to remain in you as your Son is in you, and so to live in freedom as your sons and daughters.



Removal of flowers shall be no later than 14 days after Memorial Day. If not removed by the giver, maintenance personnel shall remove and dispose of them. This ruling will not apply to flowers in containers that are part of the headstone. Removal of such will be entirely up to the giver.
