**SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:** ½ Hour before Weekend Masses.

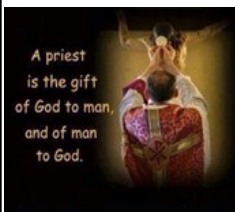

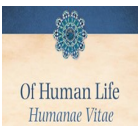
