

OUR LORD'S TWELVE PROMISES To Those Who Honor His Sacred Heart



1. "I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life."

May the Lord bless and protect her. May He be generous to her, show her His favor and give her His peace.

From time immemorial, God has chosen to draw certain men and women into silence and solitude for the "praise of the glory of His grace." These beloved souls have hidden themselves in the wilderness where God has done as He promised, "Behold I will allure her, and will lead her into the wilderness: and I will speak to her heart." (Hosea 2:16)

"Master, it is good that we are here, let us make three tents". (St. Luke 9:33; St. Matthew 17:4; St. Mark 9:5) A monastery is a sacred place of quieting down from inside, breathing more slowly and deeply. The silence is deep and the stillness draws. Attuned to the pace and purity, a resonance sinks in, the echo of something deep inside. "Be still and know that I am God". (Psalm 46:11) It is the still, small voice, a sound that cannot be heard with our ears because it must be perceived with the heart. It is the voice of God calling us out of the whirlwind of our daily clamor into the stillness of His ineffable Presence.

Cloistered life is an open witness of the reality of the existence and presence of the God, Who in today's broken world is often denied. They who dwell in monasteries live out their lives offering to God in continuous prayer, but their consecration is not made for themselves alone. In the midst of a world torn by disbelief and violence, it is made for the sake of all of God's people. Through God's grace, they understand the power of living a cloistered life of radical humility, solitude and complete surrender. 'Pluck this little flower and take it, delay not! I fear lest it droop and drop into the dust. I may not find a place in Thy garland but honor it with a touch of pain from Thy hand and pluck it. I fear lest the day end before I am aware, and the time of offering go by. Though its color be not deep, and its smell be faint, use this flower in Thy service and pluck it while there is time'.

The idea of a cloistered life strikes some as one of severity and silence, of running away from a broken heart or a broken life. It is a joyful embrace of a life that is in many ways countercultural given the me-first society that lurks beyond the monastery's walls. Cloistered religious orders are religious orders whose members intentionally separate themselves from the affairs of the external world to focus on prayer: intimacy with God. "My lover belongs to me and I to Him". (Song of Songs 6:3)

We think of monasteries as quiet places, and they are quiet, but we will be surprised by the happiness, joy and love. Within the walls of their monasteries, in the solitude of their cells, in the intimacy of the Holy Eucharist, they discover and experience "heaven and earth."

It's a way of seeking reparation for our sins and the sins of the world. The Nuns/Monks leave the concerns of their daily duties and stand before God interceding for a troubled world. Men, women and children of every land and nation are the subjects of their most sincere prayers. They have renounced the world, only to be more united to it in a supernatural way. They have come apart, making of their life a continual sacrifice of praise for the needs of all. For prayer, we need silence and we need solitude. "How great is the joy and prophecy proclaimed to the world by the silence of the cloister". (Pope Francis)
