

Faith Formation Notes for 2020-2021

- 1. Student check in will begin at 6:50pm Covid screening including temperature checks.
- 2. Any person with a temperature will not be allowed to stay for Faith Formation and will be asked to follow the guidelines of the CDC and or MDA.
- 3. Masks will be required per order of the Bishop and the Diocese of St. Cloud.
- 4. Students will go directly to their classroom.
- 5. All teachers & students must practice 6 feet social
- 6. Students & Volunteers will only be using the basement of the church for Faith Formation to limit the extra sanitation
- 7. If your child has tested positive for Covid, please contact the Faith Formation Directors so the proper documentation and protocol can be followed.
- 8. Classes will meet every other week in person. On the opposite weeks you will be expected to complete the lesson plan that has been sent home with your child. We would encourage you to spend time as a family and teach your children more about the Catholic Faith. Ex. Prayers, Rosary, Reflection, Activities/Projects, board games, & etc.

The schedule is subject to change at any time during the year.
