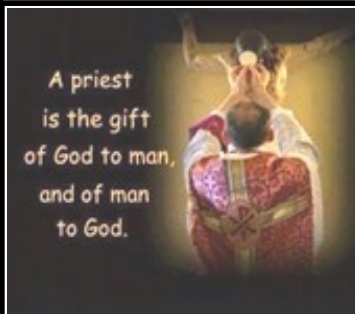

Thank you to all who are offering up prayers for our school. We are so excited that we have continued to be in school with the kids!!

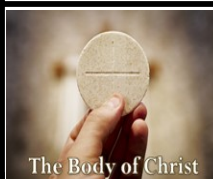
