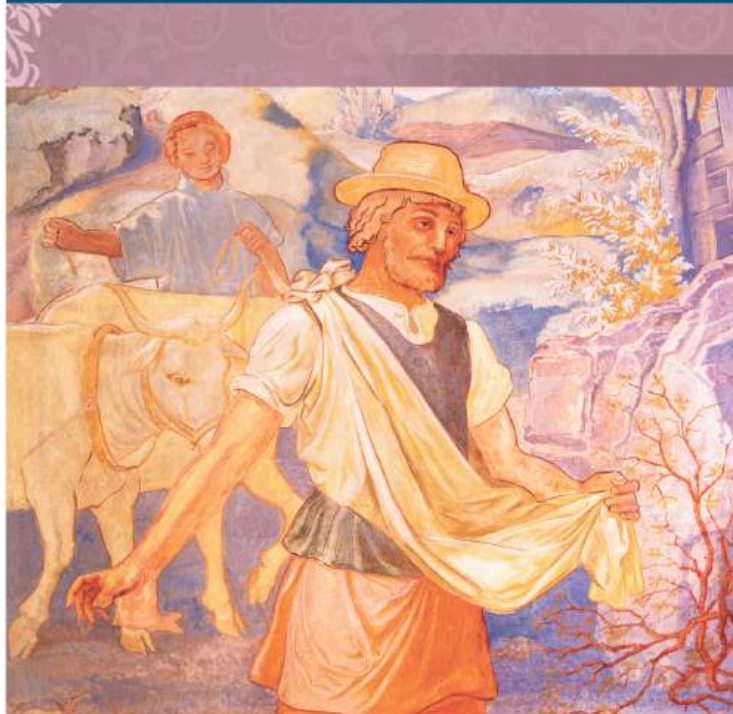

## A NOTE FROM FATHER NATHANIEL

Greetings everyone,

How do you fight the battle against sin? This week, I have been pondering the reality of sin in our life and our constant struggle against it. I was recently listening to the Poco a Poco podcast with the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal and was struck by an insight that they shared about fighting sin in our life. Often when we are fighting sin, we hyperfocus on the particulars about our struggle with that sin so that we may rid it from our life. This often leaves us discouraged though because no matter how much we try to avoid the sin or the circumstances that lead us to that sin, in our weakness, we continue to struggle and fall. The Franciscan Friars shared that it can be helpful when fighting sin to not dwell on it. Let me be clear... Sin is always evil and we should never become complacent in our sin. We should always continue to fight against sin. However, when we are fighting sin, it can be very helpful to not focus on simply getting rid of the sin but on filling the space with God. For example, if one struggles with judging others, then focus on praying for that person before encountering them. If one struggles with addiction, focus on replacing the addiction with something else instead of simply ridding yourself of the particular addiction. This emphasis helps us to rely on God's strength instead of our own strength because our strength is never enough. Never give up the fight against sin in your life. Even if you have been struggling with a particular sin for years and continue to fall again and again, come back! Jesus wants you! Praying for you all. Please pray for me.

Contact the parish offices. Requirements for having your first child baptized are: registration at a parish and attendance of a pre-baptism class. The pre-baptism class is typically offered the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month. Pre-registration is required.

Diocesan policy requires that the Pastor be contacted at least 6 months before the anticipated date of marriage to allow time for premarital inventory, instructions, and planning.

### OCIA (ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS)
