A NOTE FROM FATHER OMAR

When you hear "Last Rites" what do you think about? Yes, it is for the dying and yes, only a priest can offer it. When a Catholic person is in danger of imminent death, the family usually notifies the priest. The priest will visit the sick person to offer the Sacrament of Confession, Anointing of the Sick and Communion. If the person dies shortly after receiving the Sacraments, then we say that he or she received the Last Rites. Through the mercy of God, that person died after receiving God's grace conferred to the soul through the Sacraments.

Now, simply dying in the presence of a priest does not signify dying in God's grace; in fact, most Catholics die without a priest present and that's perfectly fine. However, we all want to be in God's grace when we die and we do so, when we regularly go to Confession, attend Mass and do not have grave sins in our soul; when we practice mercy and help others. My word of wisdom to you is: Live a holy life and be always ready! If we live as true disciples of Jesus, we'll have nothing to fear when our particular day comes.

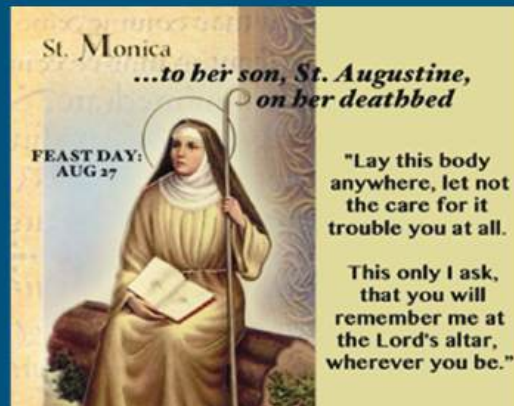
