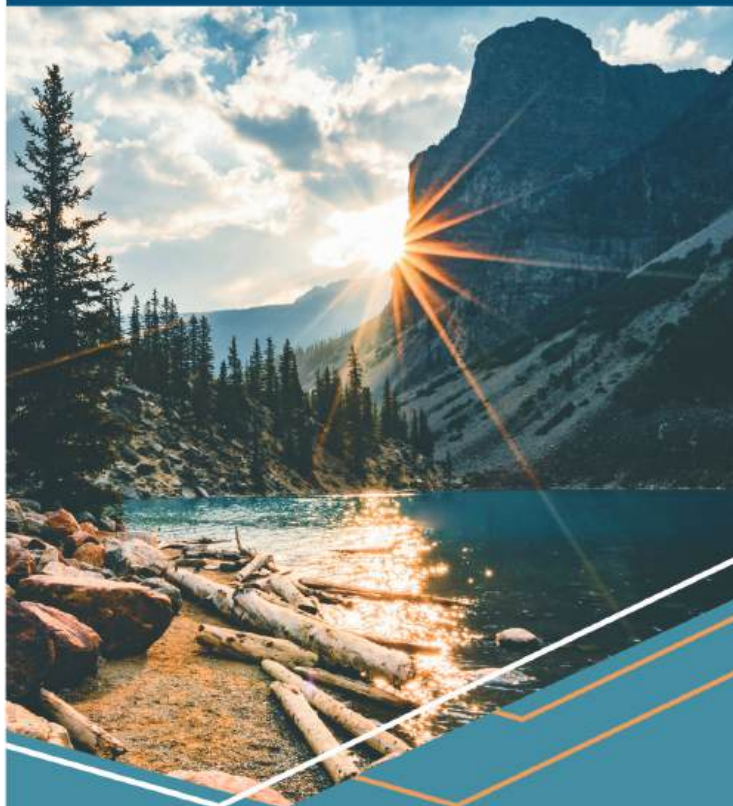

A NOTE FROM FATHER OMAR

Someone said, 'earthquakes don't kill people, buildings certainly do'. I pray with a heavy heart for all those who did not survive the two earthquakes that hit Venezuela the evening of June 24th. I was in Venezuela visiting my parents and loved ones whom I hadn't seen for eight years, and I never thought my time with them would be highlighted by one of the biggest disasters in Venezuela's history. I'm thankful to report that my family and loved ones, as well as their homes, are okay. However, our hearts are grieving the fact that thousands of people didn't survive. May God bless their souls and strengthen their loved ones!

Besides the difficulties and sadness, my time with my family was a blessing. I was able to celebrate a Mass for my parents who have been married for 53 years and spend quality time with them. I was also able to renew my Venezuelan documents and reconnect with relatives and old friends. I was inspired by the faith and resilience of the faithful that offer prayers daily and serve the Church and neighbors with a steadfast spirit. Even though the country has gone through so much in the last 25 years many people are holding on to God, our source of hope. My word of gratitude to you for remembering me in prayer while I was gone. Your prayers bore fruit! My heartfelt gratitude for your prayers for those who are suffering in Venezuela. I also want to send a blessing to all the rescue volunteers from so many countries, including the US, who went there to save lives after the earthquake. Their work of love will never be forgotten! Life will never be the same for many, but we will rise, with the help of God, like so many other nations have risen after being struck by tragedy.

The Catholic Church is of course doing everything possible to alleviate the needs of people down there and we will have the opportunity to send a little donation that will make a difference. Our Bishop Patrick Neary has asked us to have a second collection to support the victims of the earthquake and in our parish this second collection will take place at all Masses on July 25 & 26. Our donation will go through our diocesan offices directly to the Catholic Charities headquarters in Venezuela. Thank you for your support and for reading our bulletin in its new format!

May Our Lady bless us all!

Fostering the Domestic Church: Saints - Weeds and Wheat

The family is often described as the **domestic church**. It is the place where we first encounter the Lord, pray together, grow in faith, and learn what it means to live as disciples of Jesus. Like any garden, the domestic church needs to be nurtured and cultivated. My hope is that these weekly bulletin reflections will offer simple ways to help your family grow together in faith.

The Saints provide inspiring examples for every stage and walk of life. Among them are soldiers and servants, mothers and fathers, children and grandparents, scholars and laborers, the wealthy and the poor. Their lives remind us that holiness is possible for everyone.

In this weekend's homily, I mentioned four Saints whose lives looked more like **weeds than wheat** before God's grace transformed them:

- **St. Paul** oversaw the persecution and death of Christians before becoming one of the Church's greatest missionaries and evangelists.
- **St. Augustine** spent much of his youth pursuing worldly pleasures before becoming one of the most influential theologians in Christian history.
- **St. Olga of Kyiv** ruled with ruthless violence, taking the lives of thousands before her baptism led to a remarkable transformation in the way she governed.
- **St. Moses the Black** lived as a violent bandit and murderer before his conversion. He became known for his humility and mercy, even refusing to defend himself with violence when others attacked him.

Their stories remind us that God's grace is greater than our past. No one is beyond the reach of God's mercy, and every Saint has a history while every sinner has a future.

Family Goal: Choose a Saint to learn about this week. Read the story together and share what inspires each member of your family. Ask yourselves: *What can we learn from this saint about following Jesus today?*
