Sacred Heart Christian Mothers are collecting baby items to be donated to the needy. Items can be placed under the tree in the gathering space.


Requirements for having your first child baptized are: registration at a parish and attendance of a pre-baptism class. This class is normally offered 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of each






