A Note from Deacon Randy:

I have heard, since Covid, that there might be some misconception or confusion about whether attending Mass every weekend as a practicing Catholic is required and if not going to Mass to fulfill the Sunday obligation is a mortal sin? Here is what the Catechism has to say:

*Paragraph 2180: The precept of the Church specifies the law of the Lord more precisely: "On Sundays and other Holy Days of obligation the **faithful are bound** to participate in the Mass." The precept of participating in the Mass is satisfied by assistance at a Mass which is celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite either on the holy day or on the evening of the preceding day.*

*Paragraph 2181: The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason, the **faithful are obliged** to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin.*

To be a mortal sin one must have full knowledge of the sin's gravity and it must be deliberately done with one's free consent of the will.

So, yes, we are obligated as practicing Catholics to attend Mass every weekend and holy days of obligation. And if we do not fulfill our obligations, knowingly and willingly, it becomes a grave and mortal sin, which would require going to confession for one to become again properly disposed or to be in the state of grace in order to receive the Eucharist the next time we attend Mass.

We are blessed that Christ has given us the gift of the Eucharist where we can consume our Lord into our own bodies, hoping that He may change us to be more like Him from the inside out each week or even more often. Thank you, Jesus, for giving us this opportunity!

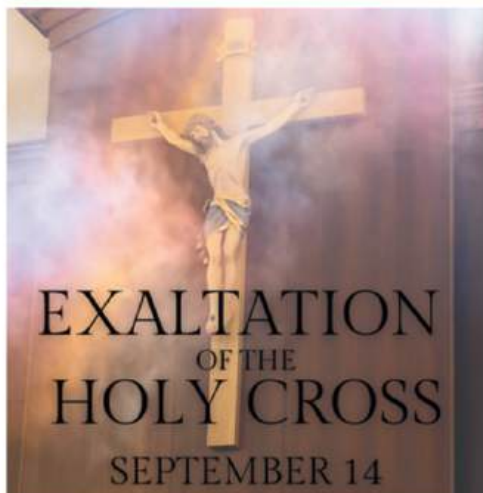

WELLNESS MINUTE

"Do you not know your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?" (1 Corinthians 6:19) God the Father created our bodies, God the Son redeemed them, and God the Holy Spirit dwells in them. Through Baptism, we become a vessel of God's glory and are called to care for our physical, mental and spiritual health by:

- Abstaining from sexual immorality and impure thoughts, words, and actions.
- Eating nutritious meals with gratitude, treating food as a gift from God that nourishes us.
- Using movement as worship to strengthen the body for service, like walking while praying.
- Observing daily rest and sleep to support dependence on God and allow the body to heal.
- Engaging in daily prayer, meditation and the Sacraments.
- Avoiding bad habits that damage the body or jeopardize the soul.

How we act, think and speak is very important. In Ephesians 4:31, Paul says to "get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, and malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as Jesus Christ forgave you." Ask yourself, "Am I becoming the person God is calling me to be?"
