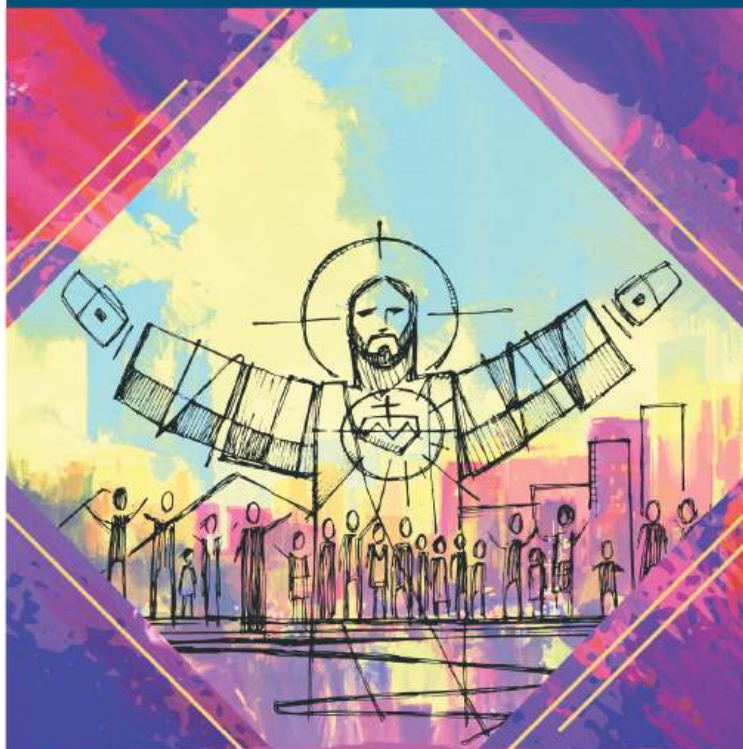

At Communion, Should I Say Amen?

When receiving Holy Communion, the minister holds up the host and says, "*The Body of Christ*." The appropriate and meaningful response is a clear, audible "*Amen*." Originating from Hebrew, this simple word means "*So be it*" or "*I believe*." Theologically, your "*Amen*" is a profound, two-fold affirmation. First, it reflects your belief in the Real Presence — that the Eucharist is truly Jesus Christ, not just a symbol. Second, it expresses your unity with the entire Catholic community. As St. Augustine taught, we become what we receive, and your "*Amen*" symbolizes your willingness to unite with Christ and His Church.

Because this word holds such deep significance, it is important to say it with intention and respect. As you approach the altar, take a moment to prepare your heart and offer a slight bow of reverence. When presented with the Eucharist, respond with a confident and sincere "*Amen*" before receiving the host. Rather than a hurried routine, let this short response serve as a genuine prayer of thanksgiving and a joyful, personal affirmation of your faith.

BAPTISM

WELLNESS MINUTE

Feeling overwhelmed and stressed? Faith calls us to give the situation to God and then take the next step, trusting that God knows where we're going even if we don't. *"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest, says the Lord."* (MT 11:28) When faced with a crisis, remind yourself: God is here, and He will not give you more than you can handle. (1 COR 10:13) Positively managing stress is a way to care for ourselves and promote health and well being:

- Identify stress triggers to help predict and plan against them before they escalate.
- Rethink work/life balance: Break tasks into smaller steps and set realistic goals.
- Sleep is medicine: Maintain a consistent sleep schedule in a cool, dark, quiet environment.
- Energize with movement: Go for a walk or bike ride to clear your mind and increase blood flow.
- Live simply: Let go of unnecessary "stuff" and distractions that hinder spiritual freedom.
