

**School Update:** A lot of progress has been made in March due to a break from the harsh winter weather. The exterior walls are now watertight and the brick and EIFS are fully underway and making very good progress. We have 150 lineal feet of wall on the ground level fully complete, or about 20% of the building perimeter complete. The entire brick/limestone/EIFS exterior should be complete in 6-8 weeks. In about 7 weeks we will start installing the exterior aluminum windows.

We have made great progress on the inside of the building as well. We now have all concrete floors poured, including the kitchen and adoration chapel. We also have all steel stud and CMU walls installed and with wood backing complete. The fire sprinkler pipe is about halfway installed. The mechanical and electrical trades are now working on finishing the rough-ins in the kitchen and fellowship hall side of the project. Next week we will start with insulating the exterior and interior walls and then start hanging sheetrock. The next big items for the interior in April will be finish taping the sheetrock and then painting!
