The 'Wheel of Fortune'

There is another circle found in many of the Gothic cathedrals that makes much the same spiritual point as the rose window. This is the so-called wheel of fortune. In most depictions of the wheel, a great circle is topped by a crowned figure, and over his head is the word 'regno' (I am reigning). Moving counter-clockwise along the rim of the wheel, we come to a man who has lost his crown and is tumbling downward, and next to him the word 'regnavi' (I have reigned). At the bottom of the wheel is the pauper dressed in rags, and his motto is the sad phrase 'sum sine regno' (I have no power). Finally, as we move upward on the right side of the circle, we come to the ambitious figure eagerly climbing to the top. And he says, 'regnabo' (I will reign). At the center of the wheel, at the meeting point of the spokes, is Christ.


