School Building Update:

As we are almost to 2022, the construction team is still racing to get the new school building enclosed, watertight, and heated. We now have all the exterior walls framed and sheathed and exterior openings temporarily enclosed with plastic poly. We are finishing up the temporary plywood doors this week and hope to start heating the main school building this week yet or early next week so we can work more efficiently inside the building out of the elements and start thawing the soil. The roof on the gym has been complete for a couple weeks and we have been heating the gym to defrost the soil to a level that will allow us to pour the concrete floor slab, which will happen soon. The roof for the main school building is a little over halfway complete and will definitely be done by the new year. We have been facing numerous winter weather events that have been slowing us down on the roofing and exterior, but we are dealing with them and moving forward.

The next month will include finishing the roof, making the exterior enclosure weather tight, dethawing the main school building, pouring the concrete floors, framing of interior walls, and mechanical and electrical rough-in.


