Epiphany marks the occasion of a time-honored Christian tradition of "chalking the doors." The formula for the ritual is simple: take blessed chalk and write the following above the entrance of your home: **20 + C + M + B + 22.**

The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Magi — Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar — who came to visit Jesus in His first home. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, *Christus mansionem benedicat*: "May Christ bless the house." The "+" signs represent the cross, and the "20" at the beginning and the "22" at the end mark the year. Taken together, this inscription is performed as a request for Christ to bless those homes so marked and that He stay with those who dwell therein throughout the entire year.

Most often the chalking takes place after Epiphany Mass, and can be done at any church, home, or dwelling. Traditionally the blessing is done by either a priest or the father of the family. This blessing can be performed simply by just writing the inscription and offering a short prayer.

The chalking of the doors of a home encourages Christians to dedicate their life at home to God and to others. Seeing the symbols over our doors can help to remind us, while passing in and out on our daily routines, that our homes and all those who dwell there belong to Christ.

Epiphany Blessing Prayer

May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same Jesus who is your incarnate Word, now and forever. Amen.

Progress on the construction of the new school continues, but rather slowly, as we have been facing very cold temperatures and lots of snow. Mid-way through last week, we were able to finish about 85% of the roofing but have not been able to continue work on the roof of the kitchen/adoration chapel due to the cold weather and snow. We will finish the roof once temperatures allow us. We were prepped and ready to pour the gymnasium concrete floor this Monday, but the concrete material plants will not allow concrete trucks on the road this entire week due to the cold weather and risk of the material freezing in the truck. However, we have finished all of the temporary plywood doors and have the entire building buttoned up nicely with plastic poly and have been thawing the main school building for the past two weeks.

This week, we are grading the soil inside the school to prep for upcoming concrete pours, and we have been installing some HVAC rough-in. We are planning to pour the gym floor Monday, January 3rd, then start prepping for the main school building concrete floor pours.

In the next two weeks we are hoping to get most of the concrete floors poured and the roof finished and then start on interior framing.
