While traveling to Damascus Saul had an encounter with the Risen Jesus Christ (Acts of the Apostles 9:1-19; Galatians 1:13-14). Jesus asks, "Saul, Saul why are you persecuting me?" Saul replies, "Who are you, sir?" Jesus responds, "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting" (Acts 9:4-5). Jesus then sent Saul to Damascus to wait for further instructions. Saul was blinded by the experience until a Christian named Ananias baptized Saul. Saul then became a follower of Christ. His name now became Paul and he went to Jerusalem to consult with Peter (Galatians 1:18). Jesus called Paul to proclaim the Gospel to the Gentiles so Paul spent the remainder of his life journeying on his missions, establishing churches, and writing to them when he heard of their accomplishments and failures. Paul's letters are the earliest records of the life and history of the early church. After his experience with Jesus Christ, Paul realized that Jesus had accomplished salvation for us. Through faith, Baptism and the grace of the Holy Spirit we are able to live in relationship with God and others.



School Building Project Update:

This week we have finally received a break in the extreme cold temperatures. This has allowed us to recontinue work on the remaining roofing, which is now just the south and east sides adjacent to the gym, roughly the last 10% of the total roof. We expect to be done with the roofing by early next week. Last week we were able to pour the gym concrete floor and with the break in the cold weather, we have made a lot of progress in dethawing the main school building area and have the soil mostly graded and ready for pouring the concrete floor. The end of this week will consist of placing plastic poly and rebar on the soil to prep for the pours. We hope to pour 2/3 of the remaining concrete floors by the end of next week. There has also been more work on mechanical and electrical rough-ins completed in the past two weeks in areas they are able to.

In the next two weeks, we plan to have all the concrete floors poured and the flat roofing complete. We should also have a good amount of the steel stud wall framing installed. Once the roofing is complete, we will start on the EIFS exterior siding on the upper gym walls. The skylights for the roof will be installed as well and more rough-in for electrical and mechanical will be completed. We hope the weather remains mild and will not affect us as much in the next two weeks as it did the prior two weeks.



